DEAR PARISHIONERS,

With Lent quickly approaching, we will be having more opportunities to participate in the Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation. Again, Fr. Michael and I will be assisting our neighboring parishes with their Lenten Penance Service, and St. Elizabeth Ann Seton will also be having a Penance Service. Please see the scheduled deanery wide Penance Services. Like in Advent, Thursday evening confessions will be cancelled since Fr. Michael and I will be away from the parish. But, as in Advent, we will be hearing confessions on Saturdays from 2:00 to 3:30 PM. Additionally, on Friday evenings, to foster the desire to enter more fully into the Paschal Mysteries, we will be having Stations of the Cross in English starting at 6 PM. Following stations, we will have Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and three priests will be available to hear confessions. At 7:30, we will have Stations of the Cross in Spanish. We will not be having the Friday evening Mass during Lent so that we may accommodate more time for the Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation. Remember that once we start Holy Week, there will be no more opportunities for confessions since required Liturgies will demand our time. As we prepare to enter the Penitential Season of Lent, I encourage our families to come at least one Friday evening to walk the Way of the Cross with Jesus.
