

Nursery Information

Here is some information that will be helpful to all moms entrusting their little ones to our care. Please know that we feel very blessed to have the opportunity to care for your children. Our mission in the nursery is to provide the safest and most loving environment possible for each and every child. In order to make this possible, we ask that you follow a few guidelines that we believe are in the children's best interest.

- Please label all bottles, sippy cups, blankets and other belongings with your child's first and last name.
- Please put nametags on each one of your children as well as their diaper bag.
- Each and every child needs to be signed in upon entering the nursery and must be signed out upon picking-up. (If a child leaves the nursery and is returned, that child must be signed back in so all children will always be accounted for.)
- Please keep the doors to the nursery and to the Parish Hall closed at all times.
- If you have a cell phone and would like to leave the number with us, please feel free to do so. We encourage you to set your phone to vibrate mode.
- If your child has any kind of allergy or special request, please notify the caregivers in the nursery to ensure that any precaution may be taken. Also, please note their nametag with allergies.
- We require that volunteers in the nursery have taken Safe Environment training.
- We ask that children who have been ill in the last 24 hours (fever, vomiting, rash, thick green nasal discharge) please stay home as to provide a safe play environment for all of the children. Your consideration is greatly appreciated.

We feel so blessed to have the opportunity to get to know you and your little ones, and are dedicated to providing for their safety and your peace of mind. Some of the things that happen in the nursery to keep your peace of mind are:

- Ms. Linda will take older kids to a separate area and lead them in songs, stories, and a craft (only if there is one or two volunteers to help out in the nursery).
- Ms. Ellie and Ms. Carlye will keep the babies (6 mos or older) and toddlers happy in the main play room.
- After the nursery closes, every toy is disinfected to keep the nursery as clean as possible.
